Fox Valley Aero Club Member Meeting Minutes May 11, 2023 at St. CharlesTownship Hall

- Welcome Members and Guests Dale Gathman.
 Dale Gathman called the meeting to order at 7:35pm
- 2. Approval of Member Meeting Minutes from April 13, 2023 Armin Weber.

Dale Gathman asked for a motion to accept the April Member Meeting minutes. Motion made by Dave Cotton, second by Dave Brustle. All approved.

Dale reminded members the June meeting will be held at the field.

3. **Treasurer's Report** – Scott Stampfli.

We are about \$6,000 up from this time last year. Income from dues has slowed.

Expenses include: AED machine & routine field expenses. (mowing, porta potties, garbage disposal).

Dale Gathman asked for a motion to accept the Treasurers report. Motion made by Jeff Mrachek. second by Bill Suhr. All approved.

- 4. **Safety Chairman's Report** Jim Thompson.
 - a. AED machine purchased.
 - b. Treeline/Berm Orientation Day. Dale reported the turnout was very light due to bad weather.

Dale did a brief demo of the AED. The machine provides step-by-step voice commands to guide the user. The machine will be kept in the pavilion in a water-proof container near the First Aid supplies.





Dale Gathman mentioned that the AMA has a program to reimburse clubs that purchase an AED machine. 25% of the purchase price up to \$200. We will apply for the reimbursement.

- 5. **Government Relations Chairman's Report** Tom Spriet. No report.
- 6. **Membership Chairman's Report** Dave Cotton.
 - a. Member count at 192.
 - b. 20 Adult, 6 Junior did not renew, not included in 192. 4 Adult expected to renew (included in 192).
- 7. **Field Chairman's Report** Dale Gathman.
 - a. Field Workday was Saturday, April 22. Around
 25 volunteers were on site. Got most of the items done.
 Still working on the pavilion roof for next few weeks.
 - b. Water Drums We have (4) 55 Gallon drums what will be filled as needed. The drums have ball valves for filling smaller containers. Dale reminded members "Do not drink the water". It's non-potable and only to be used for cleaning purposes.

c. Pop Machine status - The machine was installed and working. A 5.95% credit card fee is applied to each purchase.

Karl Griesbaum mentioned the 20th anniversary of the current field is coming up. He will send pictures/documents to Paul for the Fly Paper.

Todd will provide event flyers as needed. Todd asked if anyone knows of any Scouting groups that want to attend the Rocket Fest (August 26) to please let him know.

 - a. Memorial Day Float will be finished prior to Memorial Day. Dale asked members to support the event by walking the parade route. Dale will send an email to the membership prior to the event.
- 11. Cookout/Awards/Raffle Report Dale Gathman.
 - a. April 29 The event was a success. 80+ people turned out. The weather was good.
 - b. Thanks to Rich and Jan Gabrys and Debbie and John Howe family for getting and preparing food of Ham, Chicken, Pulled Pork. Also, Debbie for acquiring the raffle prizes and conducting the raffle.

Armin Weber brought a Top Flite Giant FW 190. The model was stripped and recovered in White Ultrakote. then painted in a winter camo scheme. The paint was airbrushed directly over the Ultrakote and sealed with automotive flat clear. The model has Sierra retracts & wheels and a DA 60cc engine.

Meeting was adjourned by Dale Gathman at 8:20pm.









Maiden Mentions




Steve Gawlik maidened his beautifully built vintage Shoestring on May 31. Congratulations Steve!

Armin Weber successfully maidened his restored Topflite FW 190 on June 3. The restoration is profiled in the May Flypaper. Great Job Armin!




