Fox Valley Aero Club Member Meeting Minutes August 10, 2023 at FVAC Flying Field

- Welcome Members and Guests Dale Gathman. Dale Gathman called the meeting to order at 7:45pm
- Approval of Member Meeting Minutes from July 6, 2023 – Armin Weber.

Dale Gathman asked for a motion to accept the July Member Meeting minutes. Motion made by Bill Suhr, second by Steve Haas. All approved.

3. Treasurer's Report – Scott Stampfli.

The balance is slightly more than this time last year. Recent income includes approximately \$600 from pop machine sales which will be used to replenish the pop. Plus, some new member dues. Climb & Glide Two Minute Timed Flight (with a twist) By Dale Gathman

We held our second Fun Fly on August 6. It was a variation of Climb and Glide. The pilots took off, and a timer was started when their wheels left the runway. When the timer hit 60 seconds, 'Throttle Cut' was called. At that point, the pilot was required to kill their power source. The goal was for the pilot to land and have their plane completely stopped when the timer hit 120 seconds (two minutes). If the flight was longer or shorter than 120 seconds, the difference in seconds was subtracted from a score of 120. Bonus points were given as follows:

20 points for a loop anytime in the flight.

20 points for a roll anytime in the flight.

20 points if the pilot landed their plane completely between two lines drawn on the runway/grass. The lines were 20 feet apart.

We had a total of ten pilots participate, and after three rounds, the results were tabulated.

10th Annual Cub Fly Report August 12, 2023 by Tom Flint and Cliff Fullhart

You Can have your Cake and Fly your Cub too!

The 10th Annual Cub Day Flying Event, Saturday August 12th , was a success. We had 33 registered pilots and about 57 Cubs. We had great weather and completed the full list of Cub Challenges. Three of our Guest Pilots were from the Peoria Club.

We started with the Cub weather prayer which helped with good weather for our Helium Balloon Challenges.

"May Perfect Wind and Weather be Upon Us! Where all good Cub landings are a must, Where perfect weather can't be beat, And each new Cub take off is a treat. In Cubs we Trust!"

The weather calmed down. Our large helium balloons stayed afloat at 10 feet off the ground so that our large and small Cubs could try to fly below and between the balloons.

I am always amazed at the control our pilots have with their Cubs for the triple touch and go challenge. The flight attributes of a Cub are just amazing. It was also fun to see the Cubs stay on the ground for 50 to 100 feet for the long roll-out challenge.

I think the biggest challenge and best pilot reaction was our Touch and Go Kamikaze Balloon Pop challenge. Six Balloons in a row were pinned to the ground with the goal of popping a balloon as you roll your plane through the row of balloons. It's much harder than it looks or sounds. Few balloons were harmed. September 2023

We exceeded our expectations for the Cub Ace Pin award with 12 Cubs in the Air at one time. The take-off was orderly and the landing was disorderly but all Cubs survived. "Just fly the yellow one" was good advice. All 12 pilots were awarded the Custom Cub Yellow Ace Pilot Award.
