Jeff Peca showed the GPS Logger he built. The small device can be installed in an airplane and will record various parameters (GPS, Altitude, Speed, etc.). The user can then download the data to a PC to review & graph their entire flight.

Larry Campbell brought a unique Gas engine from Mike-Goes-Flying. The small engine resembles a .37 glow engine except it runs on Gas/Oil mix instead of Nitro. The engine utilizes a typical glow type carburetor and special Glow plug with NO on board ignition. Very interesting.

Mark Knoppkie brought his new E-flite Super Timber. The Foam airplane features a removable battery tray, balloon tires with included pump, and the wing tube stored inside the fuselage. For 6S-Lipo with AS3X and SAFE.

Jacob Olef brought an F4 Phantom. The model was previously flown as a Glow powered Ducted Fan. Jacob plans to convert the model to EDF and have it ready for next year.

Todd Culbertson brought his new F18 from Hobby King. The small hand-launch model uses a 4S Lipo.
