# President's Message

Swap Meet – We once again had a very fun and successful February Swap Meet at the Kane County Fairgrounds. A huge thank you goes out to John 'JT' Turner and Joe Pedone, for the months of work organizing the swap, and to all of our members who helped out setting up, working the gate, doors and club table, tearing down tables and chairs, and cleaning up the room. Also thanks to Doug Swanson for overseeing the foamy fly afterwards. See coverage of this event elsewhere in this issue.

**FVAC 2025 Events** — Our calendar has been finalized and is available in this issue as well as on our website. We have been busy getting AMA sanctions for our sanctioned events, and everything is shaping up to be a fantastic year.

**Gold Leader Club** — This is the 9th consecutive year that FVAC has been awarded the status of AMA Gold Leader Club. We were also a Silver Leader Club for five years prior to that, so this is our 14th year of being a Leader Club. Thanks to Jeff Peca, who sends in our Leader Club Application every year.

When we announced at the February meeting that we were awarded the Gold Leader Club Status for this year, some members questioned what being a Gold Leader Club means. The following will help all of our members know what it takes for our club to get the Gold Leader Club Status.

### **AMA Leader Clubs:**

The AMA has established 6 goals and nine electives for clubs wishing to be a Leader Club.

- Bronze Leader Clubs must meet five of the goals and three of the electives.
- Silver Leader Clubs must meet five of the goals and six of the electives.

Gold Leader Clubs must meet all of the goals and electives.

### AMA Leader Club Goals

- 1. Be an AMA chartered club for a minimum of five years.
- 2. Club membership must be open to all AMA members and is not limited to a certain number.
- 3. Club has developed and posted Safety and Operational Rules at its flying site.
- 4. Club has filed a copy of its Safety and Operational Rules at AMA Headquarters.
- 5. Flying field has separate areas for fliers and spectators, clearly marked as such.
- 6. The AMA Safety Code is posted and visible at the club field. Program Requirement Modification: In order for a deserving club to be considered for Leader Club status, the club's district vice president may waive one of the above requirements for participation.

### Leader Club Electives:

- 1. Club has implemented and enforces a frequency control plan that allows all 50 RC channels to be used at its club flying site where RC is allowed.
- 2. Club donates to the AMA Scholarship Program or donates Model Aviation or Park Pilot magazines to a local school or library.
- 3. Club conducts a review of the AMA Safety Code at a club meeting at least once a year.

- 4. Club sponsors an annual public event, such as a mall show, flying show, or demonstration.
- 5. Club monitors noise levels and/or institutes club field rules, such as a requirement that models be operated at a maximum of 90 db at 9 feet.
- 6. Club has created an informational handout and provides it to the general public.
- 7. Club participates in charity programs or public fund-raising events.
- 8. Club has a formal lease or agreement for use of its flying site or owns its site.
- 9. Club participates in the AMA Introductory Pilot Program or has its own instruction program.

Congratulations to all of our members for helping us maintain Gold Leader Club status year after year.

I hope that you can make it to our Member Meeting on Monday, March 10 at 7:30 pm at the St. Charles Township Hall. I look forward to seeing you there. Make sure to bring any projects you have been working on. Your fellow members would love to see them. Show and Tell is always the highlight of the evening.

### Show & Tell

Dave Murray showed his new Skymaster F4 Jet. The impressive model features a factory painted camo scheme. The nomenclature and weathering was factory applied. The completed model will have all the bombs, rockets and ordinance. This updated version is 4lbs lighter than previous versions.

Power will be a P220 Turbine.





Dave Murray also showed his new Futaba 16iz Radio. The radio features dual redundancy and 900 MHZ backup.

John Howe showed his now completed Stingray 120 from the Balsa USA Kit. The model will be primarily used to test engines. John also described how Minwax Polycrylic can be used as an adhesive for ironon coverings. (Similar to Balsa Rite which is now unavailable).





Armin Weber showed Wing bags from Penn Bags. The custom wing bags are available from Pennhobby.com. They can be ordered to size or for specific models. Similar to Revoc, you can choose from many colors and options.

Jeff Mrachek showed his new Freewing Avanti S 80mm V2 EDF. The model comes ready to fly with servos, ESC, and retracts. You must add your own receiver. Jeff is getting 7-minute flights with 6s - 6000. Jeff sealed the model with Eze-Kote from Deluxe Materials, giving it a hard-shell glossy finish.



Jacob Olef showed two vintage Parkzone Stryker flying wings. One was purchased at a swap. The other was flown by Jacob's father and has been restored to flying condition. They have a pusher prop and use 3S 2600.
